ADS Facts and Figures 2023 is a collation of estimates and reported data for the year 2022. Data is compiled from a range of sources including official data from the Office of National Statistics, Oxford Economics, the Department for Business and Trade, the Ministry of Defence, and a number of reports including from the UK Space Agency, know.space and Aerospace Technology Institute, as well as ADS' own data. Data for the space sector is on a time lag and the latest data available is for the period 2020/21.






